Making Health Care Affordable

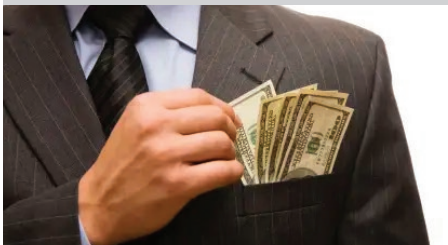
All Americans deserve access to affordable health care and prescription drugs. Workers should not be at risk of losing their health insurance simply because they lost their job.

Health Care Costs Are Too High: Even with insurance, the cost of health care continues to rise, making needed health care unaffordable. This is why we fight for lower costs.



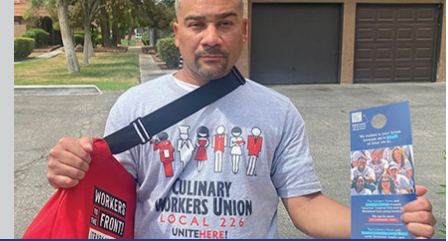

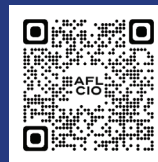
The Fight Continues: To maintain this progress and keep lowering drug costs, we must elect strong labor allies who will stand with workers against greedy corporations.
